List of cell phone numbers and outside emergency contacts
Passwords in a password vault or notebook

Shelter In Place Kit

Water in jugs or barrels
Tools – Especially a gas shut off tool

Independent Generator (not connected to the home electrical system)

Use non-ethanol based fuel (has a longer shelf life – 6mos). Renner and Miller Farm sell it (\$7/gallon).

Have extension cords on hand. The generator should never be used inside the house. You'll need to plug things into it from a distance (think refrigerator, freezer, cell phones)
