

## Diagnostic Fluoroscopy Exam Ordering Guidelines

EXAM	PREP	OIC VS HOSPITAL	ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS
ESOPHAGRAM	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY	PATIENT WILL DRINK BARIUM AT TIME OF EXAM
UGI	NPO FROM MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT BEFORE EXAM	HOSPITAL ONLY	PATIENT WILL DRINK BARIUM AT TIME OF EXAM
SMALL BOWEL FOLLOW THROUGH	NPO FROM MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT BEFORE EXAM	HOSPITAL ONLY	PATIENT WILL DRINK BARIUM AT TIME OF EXAM. INFORM PATIENT THAT EXAM <b>MAY</b> TAKE SEVERAL HOURS.
BARIUM ENEMA	PATIENT OBTAINS FROM PHARMACY (SEE PREP SHEET)	HOSPITAL ONLY	ENEMA TIP WILL BE INSERTED INTO RECTUM AT TIME OF EXAM
MODIFIED BARIUM SWALLOW	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY	<b>MUST BE COORDINATED WITH SPEECH PATHOLOGY.</b> PLEASE NOTE IF C-ARM IS NEEDED
MYELOGRAM	*SEE "SCHEDULING INSTRUCTIONS FOR MYELOGRAMS" SHEET.	HOSPITAL ONLY	USUALLY <b>CT TO FOLLOW</b>
ARTHROGRAM		HOSPITAL ONLY	SCHEDULE FOR BOTH FLUORO AND ULTRASOUND. USUALLY <b>MRI TO FOLLOW</b>
PORT DYE STUDY		HOSPITAL ONLY	PATIENT SHOULD ARRIVE WITH PORT ACCESSED BY ONCOLOGY
IVP	NO SOLID FOOD 4 HOURS PRIOR TO EXAM	HOSPITAL ONLY	INTRAVENOUS CONTRAST AT TIME OF EXAM. <b>ASK ABOUT ALLERGIES TO IODINATED CONTRAST</b>
CYSTOGRAM	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY	CATHETER INSERTION AT TIME OF EXAM

VCUG (VOIDING CYSTO URETHROGRAM)	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY	CATHETER INSERTION AT TIME OF EXAM
RETROGRADE URETHROGRAM	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY	CATHETER INSERTION AT TIME OF EXAM
HSG (HYSTEOSALPINGOGRAM)	PATIENT MAY TAKE 600MG IBUPROFEN A COUPLE OF HOURS BEFORE EXAM	HOSPITAL ONLY	MUST BE SCHEDULED 7-10 DAYS AFTER START OF PATIENT'S MENSTRUAL CYCLE. <b>BEST DAY IS THE 10<sup>TH</sup> DAY, IF POSSIBLE.</b>
SITZ MARKER STUDY	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY	PATIENT WILL SWALLOW SITZ MARKER AT FIRST APPT THEN RETURN 5 DAYS LATER FOR FILM. <b>NO LAXATIVES/ENEMAS/STOOL SOFTENERS.</b>
LUMBAR PUNCTURE	NO BLOOD THINNERS (USE SAME GUIDLINE AS MYELOGRAM)	HOSPITAL ONLY	
T-TUBE CHOLANGEOGRAM	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY	PATIENT MUST HAVE T-TUBE ALREADY PLACED
"SNIFF TEST"	NO PREP	HOSPITAL ONLY
