- Please ask your patient to contact us within 5-10 business days after sending the referral, to schedule the appointment.
- Fax referral to 707-441-1711
- Due to the high volume of referrals, we are booking out anywhere from 4-6 weeks. We will triage your referrals for urgency.
- If your referral is urgent, (ie: diabetics with open wounds, a wound or ulcer, any new crush injury, recent fracture of serious injury to tendons, ligaments, etc), please call our office at 707-441-1112 to let us know the referral is coming. Flat feet, plantar fasciitis, ingrown toenails, old fractures, fungus, corns, callouses, non-injurious foot pain, etc are not necessarily urgent and will be triaged by referral coordinator.
