

We are happy to be part of your medical team. For most people, their primary care practice is the hub of their care. We will communicate with your primary care practice about your medical care in our practice so that your care is coordinated. We will send a report after each visit and if needed call your primary care team to coordinate testing and treatments. We will also work with and coordinate with your other specialists by providing a copy of your visit report to them or calling them if needed.

We specialize in ENDOCRINOLOGY. You have been referred here for PRINCIPAL CO-MANAGEMENT (co-management with the specialist leading the care and taking first call for a specific condition).

Both practices are part of your care team. We will be helping you with the management of a special health issue, prescribing and adjusting the medications and other treatments for that condition and monitoring the responses as part of ongoing care.

If additional testing is needed at the time of your referral, then we will communicate those results to you by phone and/or the patient portal or by a follow up appointment if the issues are complex or if we need to discuss different options.

Your care plan will be decided upon by discussing your options with your input as to what will work best for you. You will receive a copy of the plan with the medical summary that is printed for you at check out.

Periodic follow up appointments will be scheduled depending on the condition and its stability.

The type of referral or relationship that you have with the specialist can change if your condition changes. If the condition resolves or stabilizes you might not need any further help from the specialist. If a condition deteriorates or becomes more complicated, you might need additional co-management for a while.
